

By signing this Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risk, I, the undersigned:

1. Acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by participating in any activity outside of our home, including performances organized by Outcry Youth Theatre (the "Activities"), and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and/or death.

2. Understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 may be increased by participation in the Activities, and that such exposure or infection may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Outcry employees, volunteers, and other participants and/or their families.

3. Agree to notify an Outcry employee immediately if I find out that anyone who attended a performance has tested positive for COVID-19.

4. Acknowledge that if I notify Outcry that an audience member has tested positive for COVID-19, Outcry will inform the rest of the audience members, actors, and volunteers that they have potentially been exposed.

5. Acknowledge the enhanced risks of participants being in direct contact with anyone age 65 or older for 14 days after attending a performance, and acknowledge the enhanced risk of attendance by anyone ages 65 or older.

6. Acknowledge that all audience members will be required to wear a mask at all times when they are attending an Outcry performance.

7. Understand that these protocols are necessary for the health and safety of all participants in the Activities.

8. Take full responsibility for my adherence to all such protocols including self-screening prior to attending an Outcry performance. I will not attend a performance if I exhibit any of the following symptoms: fever, shortness of breath, cough, or sore throat.

9. Acknowledge that the MCL Grand will establish a single consolidated, ADA accessible, checkpoint through which anyone entering the facility will receive temperature checks in accordance with City policy. These temperature checks will be facilitated by MCL Grand staff. Any person found to have a temperature greater than 100.4 (average, after 3 attempts) will not be permitted further into the building. All other entry points will be locked, and signage will be posted to encourage entry through the designated entry point. MCL Grand staff may open an additional ADA accessible entry point if necessary.
